## INFORMATION REGARDING HOUSE EXAMINATIONS

Each year group has been given their respective examination timetable which has already been posted on the school App. Please refer to this for your daughter's start, finish and lunchtimes over the next fortnight. Examination procedures have been explained to your daughter and some of this information is outlined below.

Please note that as examinations will be taking place throughout the course of the two weeks the school day will run from 8:30-3:00 on each day.

- All students who have an exam at any time in the morning must be in their exam venues for roll call at 8:25 a.m. having first swiped in. (Students will be supervised for study in exam venues until start of exam).
- All students who have an afternoon exam must be in their exam venues for registration at 12:50 p.m.
- Students may go home at the scheduled finish time of the exam.
- If a student has no exam on a particular morning or afternoon she may stay at home. However, Junior Cycle students (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Years) who do not have an exam on a particular day must present for study for half of that day (morning or afternoon) unless they bring in a note from their parents giving them permission to stay at home.
- TY students must stay in the exam centres on Monday for the full day. Study for Tuesday's examination will be facilitated during the Irish Orals.
- Lunch is to be eaten in exam centres. A reminder that the canteen will run on a Pre Order basis for the next two weeks.
