## 6th Year Parents Information January 2024

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

Happy New Year and we hope you had a good Christmas. We understand that completing college applications can be challenging for our 6th Year students. We are here to support the students. Please encourage them to reach out to us if they have difficulties or queries about their applications. Below please find some information about college applications. #### **CAO Applications**

All students who are applying to CAO should now have opened their CAO accounts. A reminder that the closing date for the discounted application fee is **20 January**. The closing date for applications is **1 February**. Students must have their application completed by this date including your courses in the correct order of preference. Students will be able to change their courses, free of charge, during the change of mind dates from **5 May to 1 July**. All restricted application courses must be applied for by **1 February** and cannot be added later using the CAO the change of mind facility.

#### DARE/HEAR

Closing date for final completion of the DARE/HEAR application is 1 March but we strongly advise students to complete their application earlier. DARE/HEAR supporting documentation must be sent to CAO by the deadline of 15 March. Obtaining this information from outside agencies can take time. Students are strongly advised to gather this information well in advance of the deadline. #### Irish/Language Exemptions

All students who do not study Irish and/or another language should now have applied for their language exemptions as instructed by the CAO and have received confirmation that their exemption was granted. If students have not completed this process or have not received confirmation please let us know so that we can assist you with this. It is vital to have these in order prior to the college offers.

#### **Further Education & Training - PLC Applications**

Most PLC colleges are now open for online application on their websites. Students are recommended to apply early. Please complete the online application if you wish to apply. You may need your PPS number to apply.
