Dear parent/guardian,

I hope that this letter finds both you and your families well. As we approach the festive season, I would like to ask for your support in a fundraising initiative for Our Lady's School. The focus of this fundraising is to assist in the upgrade of our sports facilities with the intended completion of a world-class sports dome this year. Building off the success of previous years, we will be running our annual "12 Gifts of Christmas" raffle again with all proceeds going towards the last push to complete the costs of this very ambitious project.
