

IMPORTANT SCHOOL POLICY REMINDERS

- The School Code of Positive Behaviour must be signed by students and parents in the school journal. We are grateful for your support in these matters.
- Mobile phones. Mobile phones may be kept in the student's locker or turned off in her bag and should not be carried by the student on her person.
- School uniform. School tracksuits may be worn for the full day only on PE days. No facial (brow/nose/lip/tongue) piercings are permitted. For reasons of hygiene and health and safety, short cut nails are mandatory.
- If a student is unwell in school, she must tell a teacher and seek permission to attend reception. If required, a phone call will be made home. For reasons of health and safety, students are required to go through this channel and may not use mobile phones to contact home.
- Attendance and punctuality. Students arriving late to school must sign in at reception.
 Parents will receive a notification at the time of sign-in via the school app (please note that you must have the push notifications switched on for the app in the settings of your phone). Parents / guardians are asked to please schedule all medical appointments outside of the school day or on a Wednesday afternoon after school to avoid students losing out on valuable tuition time.
