I would like to thank you and your families for the continued support that you have shown the staff and students of Our Lady's throughout this year. It has been an exceptionally busy year and we are all delighted to be back to in person meetings and gatherings. Classrooms are again alive with the sound of active group learning and there is a greater sense of engagement with classwork thanks to the lifting of restrictions.
