Applications for a grant can be made by completing a 'Book Grant Form', which is available to download from the school website. Please send in forms, with receipts, to the office when your daughter returns to school. If you have any queries regarding this, please do not hesitate to contact us. All queries will be handled in the strictest of confidence.
