IMPORTANT SCHOOL POLICY REMINDERS

- The School Code of Positive Behaviour must be signed by students and parents in the school journal. We are grateful for your support in these matters.
- **Mobile phones.** Mobile phones may be kept in the student's locker or turned off in her bag and should not be carried by the student on her person.
- School uniform. School tracksuits may be worn for the full day only on PE days. No facial (brow/nose/lip/tongue) piercings are permitted. For reasons of hygiene and health and safety, short cut nails are mandatory.

Parents / guardians are asked to please schedule all medical appointments outside of the school day or on a Wednesday afternoon after school to avoid students losing out on valuable tuition time.
