



Suggested Guidelines for Students for Learning At Home

Get organised:

- Try to set up a "home classroom space".
- Start your work when the school day starts.
- Follow the school timetable to keep up with the work that has been set.
- Don't watch favourite shows / use social media during school time.



Follow work plans set by each teacher for each subject:

- Keep up to date with Google Classroom and the resources shared by your teacher.
- Use this platform to ask for help when needed. You can contact your class teacher through your Google classroom during the school day, 8.30am to 3.50pm Mon and Tues and 3.10pm, Wed, Thurs and Fri.
- Keep up practice for practical subjects such as Home Economics, Art, Music, etc.
- Use feedback from previous assignments to guide current assignments.



Track your learning:

- Keep your journal updated: subjects, time taken, reading, study. Parents can check this.
- It will be very helpful when you get back to school if you can keep a diary of your home learning experience.
