## **Attendance Matters**

During the last term we have noticed an increase in the number of students arriving late to school and signing out early. The negative impact of this on a student's learning can be extensive. Not only does a student miss out on important class time but they are disrupting the learning of others by arriving late to class. Every day a student is late or absent is a lost opportunity for learning. Too many absences not only can seriously impact achievement for the absent student but also can disrupt learning for the entire class.

Research shows that students who consistently miss school or who are late to class are at risk of lower academic achievement.

I am asking for your support to improve student punctuality to school and to discourage any appointments during class time unless absolutely necessary. Parental involvement in ensuring consistent timely attendance in school is key to promoting student attainment.





From Monday 17th April, on the return to school after the holidays any late student must as usual sign in at reception. Locker rooms will be locked at the first bell and students will only be able to access their lockers at the break times. Parents will be contacted by Reception when 3 lates are accumulated and subsequent lates will trigger additional sanctions for students such as detention and punctuality tracker documents.

Lateness due to traffic and buses will not be accepted as an excuse and a late will be recorded. Please schedule all medical appointments outside of the school day or on a Wednesday afternoon after school.
