We will also hold some class meets to discuss dealing with college offers and your transition into college/ training plus other topics that you request information on. The following guidelines have been given by the Department of Education: Guidance Counsellors are permitted to continue to provide guidance counselling support to 6th year students (1:1 and small group work). Guidance counselling support may be provided to students wishing to discuss their social personal, education and career concerns.

However, In advance of any planned interaction with students a clear statement must be communicated to students and parents/guardians that **the guidance counsellor will not** be engaging in discussions regarding the calculated grading process or potential marks awarded by teachers. Guidance Counsellors, teachers and students may not discuss the student's achievement in the subject over the past two years. Nor can they discuss the student's ranking in a class, or their estimated mark or the level at which an estimated mark is to be provided in a subject.

It is vital that you now reflect carefully on your applications and ensure that you are happy with them. For CAO applicants you have until the 1st July 2020 to ensure your application is correct and your courses are in your genuine order of preference. It is always a good idea to have a back up plan. If you have applied and have an offer from a PLC college that is great and just need to ensure you read any further information that you receive from the colleges carefully. It is also important to note that it is not too late to apply and PLC colleges are still accepting online applications. Application to apprenticeships can still be made also.
