	Access to results breakdown opens 5.00 p.m.	Through the self-service portal students can access details of their accredited grade (given by S.E.C.) and/or the result of the written exam, and thereby determine the sources of the final result received.	
	Applications to view written scripts opens 5.00 p.m.	Apply on-line through self-service portal to view written component of exams taken in June.	
Wed. 8 th Sept.	Applications to view written scripts closes 8.00 p.m.	Note short timeframe.	
	Available college places open on C.A.O. 12.00 p.m.	These are places that have not been filled in certain course.	
Sat. 11 th Sept.	Written Script Viewing Session in school/on-line	Written scripts marked on paper can be viewed in the school. School will allocate a time to students.
