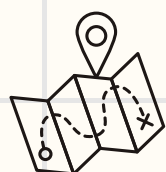


TY UPDATES

The insurance letter has also been updated - please see the TY Google Classroom to access the updated letter.

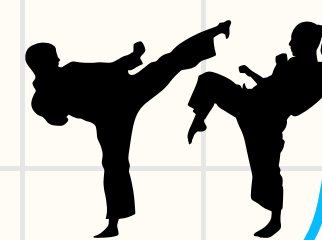
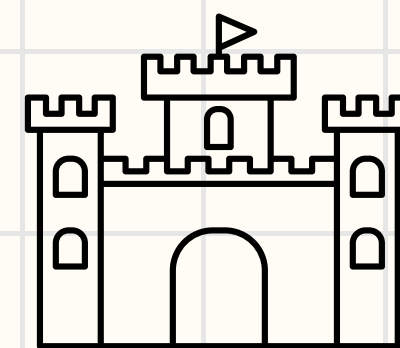
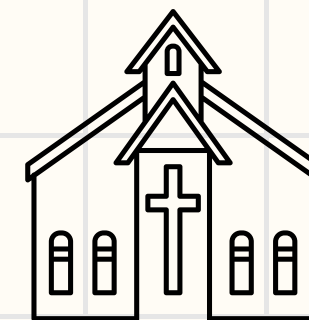


Development Day

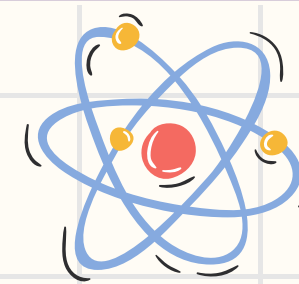
It was a wonderful experience and the TYs enjoyed the learning experience and time with their class. A big thank you to the staff involved in supervising all activities.

- Have a fun learning experience on work experience next week! When you return to school, you will take part in your TY mid year interviews so ensure you E-Portfolio is up to date!!

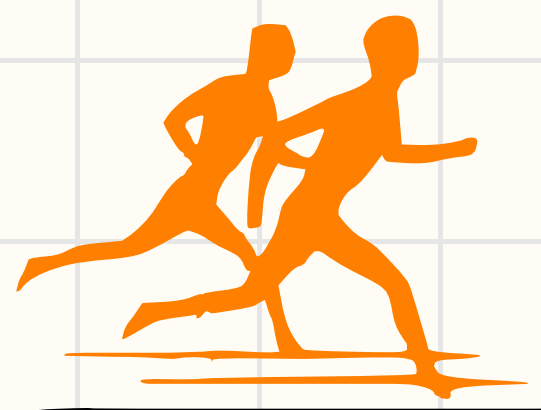
Scifest
